

Funding opportunities for PhD students and post-docs

Prof. Marco Paggi, IMT Lucca

Abstract:

The seminar aims at providing an overview on funding opportunities for PhD students, post-docs, and researchers (scholarships by the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation; initiatives by the Deutscher Akademischer Austausch Dienst; scholarships offered by the Royal Society in UK; bilateral Italy-France exchange programmes; Fulbright scholarships; Marie Curie actions; grants for researchers provided by the European Research Council). Specific hints on how to write a proposal are given.

Prof. Marco Paggi is associate professor of Structural Mechanics, director of the research unit Multi-scale Analysis of Materials and director of the PhD track in Computational Mechanics at the IMT Lucca. His research interests are in computational mechanics, interface/contact/fracture mechanics, multi-physics simulations. He is member of the Young Academy of Europe and winner of many prizes and awards for his research achievements. He is the principal investigator of a ERC starting grant for young researchers and national coordinator of a FIRB project. At IMT Lucca, Prof. Paggi teaches, among other courses, a graduate course on Funding and Management of Research and Intellectual Properties.
